1. LITTLE VOICES FOR HEALTHY CHOICES: AGOO AMEE

Developed by Kofi Dennis

Description and Objectives:

In this experience, Wolf Trap Teaching Artist Kofi Dennis demonstrates a call and response experience from the language of the Akan people of Ghana. This experience can be used to create focus, as a classroom management tool, and/or as a transition.
