Wolf Trap is expanding its offerings in Virginia for **pre-K through first grade** (also available in-person or virtually). Here's how we can work with your community:



CLASSROOM RESIDENCIES

Through a Classroom Residency, educators receive hands-on experience working with a Wolf Trap Teaching Artist in their classroom. Together, educators and teaching artists plan and implement innovative lesson plans grounded in the performing arts, aligned with key developmental skills, and customized to the classroom and curriculum. *Residencies consist of six sessions including a planning meeting and classroom sessions.*



PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOPS

These interactive sessions led by Wolf Trap Master Teaching Artists increase teachers' confidence in using the performing arts to foster children's cognitive, social and emotional, and physical development. Topics include math, science, language and literacy, problem solving, and classroom management. *In person workshops are three hours in length; Virtual workshops are one hour in length.*



FAMILY WORKSHOPS

Family Workshops provide children and their parents/caregivers with an opportunity to share a stimulating live arts experience, led by a Wolf Trap Teaching Artist. Parents will leave with arts-integrated activities they can use at home. *In person workshops are one hour in length; Virtual workshops are 30 minutes in length.*
