


PUMPKIN ETCHING TEMPLATE


- 1. Print out the pattern and trim off any excess paper.
- 2. Tape or use pins to affix the pattern to the pumpkin.
- 3. Using a thumbtack, straight pin, or wooden pick, poke holes about every $\frac{1}{8}$; to $\frac{1}{4}$ inch along design lines on the edge you are supposed to etch.
- Carefully remove template and scrape away just the top layer of skin (represented by the dotted area) along pierced lines.





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
